ACTIVE LEARNING

Teachers from both the **English and French** departments came together for a collaborative session in **Checkpoint I** classes. They talked about French words that are used in English. They discussed where these words come from and what they mean. The session showed how different subjects can connect and help us learn more about languages and cultures. It was an opportunity for teachers to collaborate and make learning more engaging for students.



In their **Global Perspective** class, the children of **Checkpoint I** made informative posters about topics like **Migration**. This helped them understand various viewpoints on a global, national, and local scale. The project also improved important skills such as **researching, analyzing, working together, and communicating effectively.** These activities encouraged students to learn more about complex global problems and expand their knowledge.



A **collaborative math and art project** titled "**Number Art**" was conducted for **CP I** students wherein they were taught to creatively depict various shapes and figures using numbers ranging from 1 to 9. This interdisciplinary activity aimed to reinforce numerical understanding while fostering artistic expression and creativity in young learners.



ACTIVE LEARNING

CP I students had an immersive, hands-on learning opportunity as they crafted various landforms from clay, simultaneously delving into the **STEM** subject of different geographical features. The activity aimed to foster creativity while reinforcing understanding of **Earth's diverse landscapes.**





CP II students immersed themselves in active learning, gaining hands-on experience with concepts such as **length**, **area**, **perimeter**, **mass**, **capacity**, **and temperature**. Through collaborative, engaging and practical experiments, they explored these fundamental **mathematical and scientific principles**, fostering a deeper understanding of measurement and its applications in real-world contexts. This interdisciplinary approach aimed to make learning both meaningful and memorable for young learners.



ACTIVE LEARNING

During an active learning session in **CP II**, students created an '**Emotion Wheel**' to articulate their feelings in various situations and proposed solutions for coping with them, all within the context of the **STEM** topic of **emotions and feelings.** This engaging activity encouraged self-reflection and problem-solving skills development.





In **CP II STEM** class focusing on the topic **sound**, students embarked on a creative project where they crafted **musical instruments** using recycled materials. This hands-on activity not only allowed them to explore the science behind sound production but also encouraged environmental awareness. Through experimentation and innovation, students gained a deeper understanding of acoustics while showcasing their resourcefulness in sustainability.
