What is the difference between IGCSE Core and IGCSE Extended?

- To take into account differing abilities, there is a choice between Core and Extended curriculum papers in some subjects.
- The Core curriculum is within the ability range of a large majority of students. It provides a full overview of the subject and is targeted at students expected to achieve grades C to G.
- The Extended curriculum has been designed for the more academically able. It is targeted at those expected to achieve grades A* to G.

ICE AWARD - INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION

Do you qualify for **ICE Award**? Learners must take two different languages from Group I, and one subject from each of Groups II, III, IV and V. The seventh subject can be taken from any of the five subject groups.

- Group I: Languages - English, Hindi, French
- Group II: Humanities and Social Sciences - Economics, Environmental Management, History, Global Perspectives
- Group III: Sciences - Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Management
- Group IV: Mathematics - Mathematics, Additional Mathematics
- Group V: Creative and Professional - Accounting, Art and Design, Business Studies, Information and Communication Technology, Computer Science.

Learners must take two different languages from Group I, and one subject from each of Groups II, III, IV and V. The seventh subject can be taken from any of the five subject groups.

ICE AWARD - INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION

Students who qualify for the Cambridge ICE award will be placed in one of three categories:

Distinction - Grade A or better in five subjects and grade C or better in two subjects.

Merit - Grade C or better in five subjects and grade F or better in two subjects.

Pass - Grade G or better in seven subjects.

Through the Cambridge ICE students can demonstrate competence across a wide range of subjects and skills.

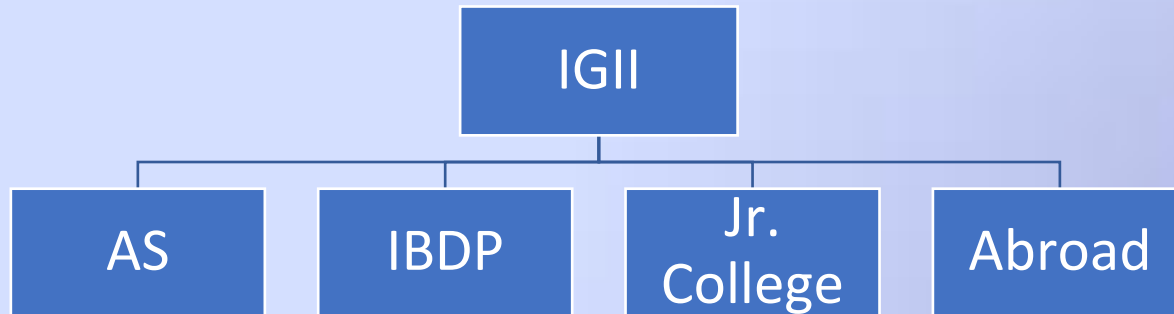
